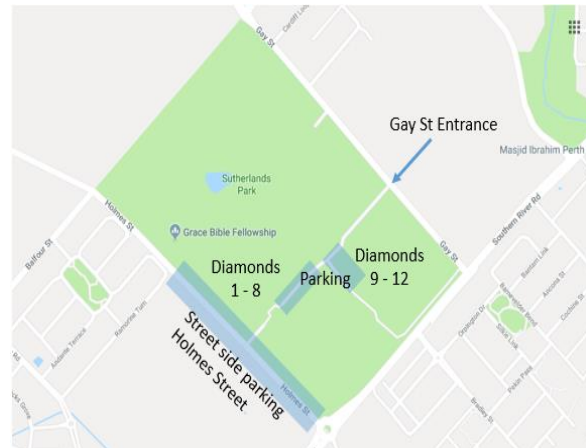

Games Game duration is to be 50 minutes, commencing on the hour. A siren will sound at the commencement and completion of each game. For diamonds who are too far away to hear the siren, or siren failure, game times commence and conclude according to the plate umpire's time keeping.

Outfielders must wear helmets on diamonds 1, 2, 5 and 6. Umpires' and coaches' discretion to be used for outfielders on Diamonds 3, 4, 7 and 8

In order to maximise play time for the kids, please note the following:

- Home team to be on the field ready for the start of the game
- Time calls from coaches should be restricted to injuries
- Innings changeovers to be restricted to 1 minute
- At the end of the game, vacate dugout as quickly as possible to allow next team to get set up

Upon the siren, only the current play can be completed, no new plays are to commence, and Time and Game must be called. For incomplete innings, the score for the game will revert back to the previous completed innings under the following conditions

- The team batting second is behind. And/Or
- The team batting second has not commenced their turn batting.

Equipment Thornlie and Districts will provide diamond equipment. At the conclusion of the last game, please place all items in the trolley or at home plate.

Tees are to be provided by the HOME team as listed in the fixtures. Fold down tees only are permitted. Other than equipment failure, tees cannot be changed during an innings.

Balls are to be provided by the HOME team. A reasonable quality ball appropriate to the age group shall be provided for the game. 9's and 10's will use a Tee-ball, 11's and over will use a Baseball.

Diamond info	<p>Shade will only be supplied for SCORERS, with teams requiring their own team shade.</p> <p>Thornlie and Districts will occupy the same diamonds for the duration of the day, logically this means the teams will occupy the same base line for the duration of the day regardless of home and away within the fixtures. This will not affect which team bats first (Away team) nor umpiring duties.</p> <p>At the conclusion of the last game, we ask that the scorers shade be packed away and placed with rest of diamond equipment</p>
Umpiring	<p>Teams listed first in the fixtures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provide the Home plate umpire</li><li>• Field first</li><li>• Occupy the first base line (With the exception of T&amp;D games)</li></ul> <p>Teams listed second in the fixtures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Provide the Field umpire</li><li>• Bat first</li><li>• Occupy the third base line</li></ul>
Scoring	<p>Each team is to provide their own score book. There will be no score cards issued by Thornlie and Districts. Any injuries must be noted in the score books.</p>
Dress/Uniform	<p>All umpires, coaches, base coaches, team managers, team officials and scorers <b>MUST</b> wear enclosed shoes, a shirt and a hat. Sandals, thongs or singlets are not permitted.</p> <p>Jewellery is not permitted on the diamond with the exception of Medic-Alert bracelets or necklaces which <b>MUST</b> be taped securely to the player's body.</p> <p>Pitchers of all age groups must wear helmet with face guard and a chest plate.</p> <p>Batters and base runners of all age groups must wear a helmet. No player is to be allowed to wear a hat backwards underneath a helmet (Including Pitchers)</p>
First Aid	<p>First Aid will be available near the clubhouse adjacent to Diamond 1.</p>
Toilets	<p>There are multiple toilets at both groups of Diamonds. 1 – 8 will have access to club house toilets while Diamonds 9 – 12 will have "Portaloos" provided.</p>
Drinking/Smoking	<p>The grounds at Thornlie and Districts are both Smoke and Alcohol free. We do ask smokers to remove themselves from the playing fields if they do wish to smoke. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in a 9 – 0 forfeit.</p>
Canteen facilities	<p>There will be a canteen operating at the main clubroom adjacent to Diamond 1</p> <p>BBQ sausage sizzles will also be operating at both ovals.</p>
